The FELASA Award will be judged by a  
panel of invited experts and  
representatives of the FELASA  
Governing Board, whose decision is final



FELASA established in 2007 a triennial Award to recognize and reward a defined piece of original scientific work on any aspect of laboratory animal science, housing, husbandry or welfare that could lead or has led to changes or improvements into how animals are utilized in research, testing or education within Europe and that is consistent with FELASA's aims and objectives.

The recipient(s) of the 2010 FELASA Award will be required to present the results of their work at a platform session during the FELASA 2010 Symposium, 14-17 June in Helsinki, Finland ([www.felasa.eu](http://www.felasa.eu)), at which they will also receive their award of an inscribed plaque, and a prize of €2,000.

Nominations should include:

- A *curriculum vitae* with refereed publications
- Full details of the scientific work including any existing publications
- The contribution the work has made to the stated objectives of the award
